# **Library News**

Students may check out Ebooks and audiobooks from the school library in the summer. To access the collection, go to the school's website and scroll down to the virtual library. Click on the link to enter and click on Ms. Sandberg. Students may log into the site using the login tab on the right upper portion of the screen. Students will need their school login information to check out items. Scroll down on the Destiny library site to see Ebooks and Audiobooks. You may read books or listen to books without being logged in or signing them out, but if someone else signs the book out you will not have access to it. If you sign the book out, it also saves your place when you are reading or listening to it. If you do not have it signed out and exit Destiny, the next time you go into the site, it will not have your spot saved.

At the top of the Destiny Discover site, there is also a tab labeled "SORA." Students have access to a collection of ebooks and audio books from the public library due to a partnership between Chinooks Edge and the Parkland Regional Library system. SORA may be accessed by students in grade 4 and up.
