5.1 Principal's Report: Mrs. Eadie Gyori & Mrs. Normoyle

- Student achievement – Reading results over the last 5 years - there has been a dip in the past but we have caught back up with 94% reading at or above grade level.

-There are many important benefits from kids reading and achieving their reading levels

- most grade levels are doing well with writing skills. Writing stamina is the piece that we are seeing some struggles in.

- Numeracy - this year we were at 80% last year75%

Social Emotional Wellness – growth and development are a critically important to our students. There is explicit teaching by Mrs. Hann. In Focus Program and the Yes Program.

- Misbehavior is a time that we are growing our brains

- Career connections – we have a critically important role at the elementary level. This is done through Passion Projects, researching a career and make a display, career fair for grade 6 – share their projects, guest speakers to come in

- PAT exams – English, Social, Science – improvements from last year. 80% and 85% at an acceptable standard.

- French writing – 78% met the acceptable standard

- School Plan – (basically all the stuff mentioned above) They used the Chinooks edge plan and then modified it to better suit our school.
